Pedestrian and Cycle paths between Hookwood and Reigate on the A217

The Mole Valley Local Committee have recently agreed an application to the Department for Transport for a share of additional funding that's been made available under the Safer Roads Scheme.

The draft proposals put forward by Surrey Highways do not include any provision for additional pedestrian or cycleway on the route.

The Charlwood Parish Council have discussed this and have written to the Local Committee asking that any design considered for the project should include greater provision of pedestrian and cycle pathways along the whole route.

Local residents have raised a petition for this to be considered and the link to the petition appears below.

Whilst the Parish Council support the need for improved pedestrian and cycle ways along the A217, this petition has been drafted by a third party and is not submitted by the Parish Council.
